Glacier 3000 Experience

A day you will remember all your life.

Touch the sky with a great panoramic helicopter flight over the Swiss alps and discover a Unique Panorama, 24 peaks over 4'000 metres at a glance: The View Point at 3'000 metres offers an indescribable view onto the most beautiful alpine peaks.

Glacier 3000 can do much more than just look nice: The glacier area is surprisingly diverse and guarantees a wide selection of activities: take a walk on the 107m Peak Walk by Tissot. It is the first hanging bridge in the world that connects two peaks, the Alpine Coaster, the world's highest bobsleigh track or the Snow Bus.

After a nice meal in Gstaad, you will take the Panoramic-Express, on the famous Golden Pass Line from Lucerne to Montreux.

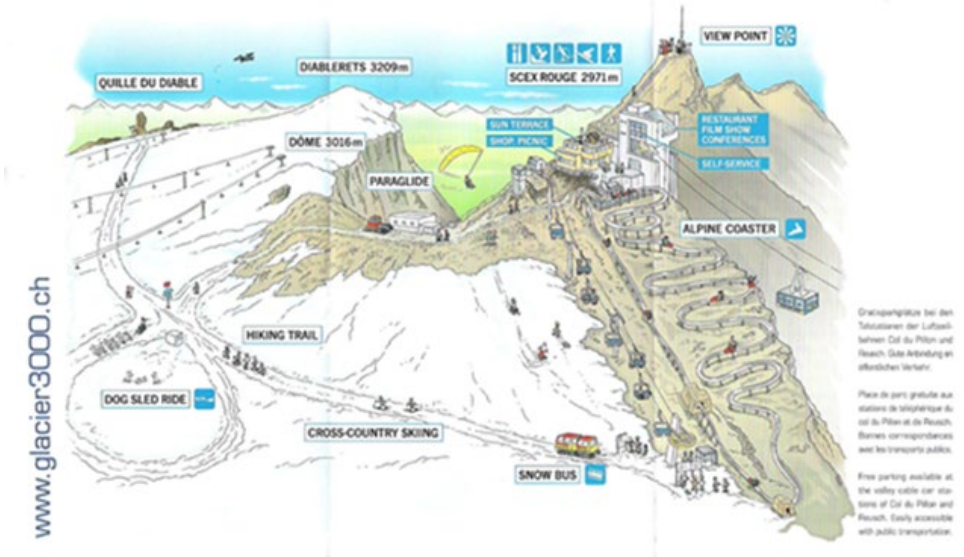

Glacier 3000

Cableway, architecture, adventure and Alpine mountain scenery – visitors experience all of it and then some on this journey to a unique glacier world. Already the first glimpse of the summit station designed by architect Mario Botta is spectacular. Immediately, a stunning panorama of no fewer than 24 snow-capped 4000-metre giants reveals itself: Eiger, Mönch, Jungfrau, Matterhorn, Grand Combin and even Mont Blanc in the distance.

Altitude	2965 m a.s.l.
Attractions	Peak Walk by Tissot – the world’s first suspension footbridge spanning two summits, sledge dogs, snow bus, hiking on the glacier plateau, Alpine Coaster (highest toboggan run) climbing park Gamskopf, summer loipe (cross-country ski track) and helicopter glacier flight
Food & beverage	Summit restaurant with a view over the glacier plateau to the Alps of Valais, Refuge l’Espace (mountain lounge) next to the “Quille du Diable” with a view down 1400 metres to erborance
Specials	Circular restroom window with the most beautiful view

Peak walk by Tissot

There is only one suspension bridge in the world that connects two mountain peaks. It is called Peak Walk by Tissot. It can be found at Glacier 3000. And it invites you to an adventure that you will not easily forget.

The Peak Walk by Tissot is the highlight of the glacier adventure: It connects the smaller peak (View Point) with the 5 meter higher main peak (Scex Rouge) and takes all guests to incredible heights. The 107 metre long and 80 centimetre wide bridge offers a stunning view onto the Alps: Matterhorn, Mont Blanc, Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau are visible from the bridge and offer grandiose views, far off into the distance.

The suspension bridge is free of charge and open year-round subject to weather conditions.



The Goldenpass Gstaad - Montreux

The Panoramic-Express is a part of the famous Golden Pass Line from Montreux to Lucerne. The golden-colored, elegant trains take passengers from the banks of Lake Geneva via the famous resort town of Gstaad to Interlaken in the Bernese Oberland.
